

Commitment with SDGs from university, students and teachers, from the service learning methodology

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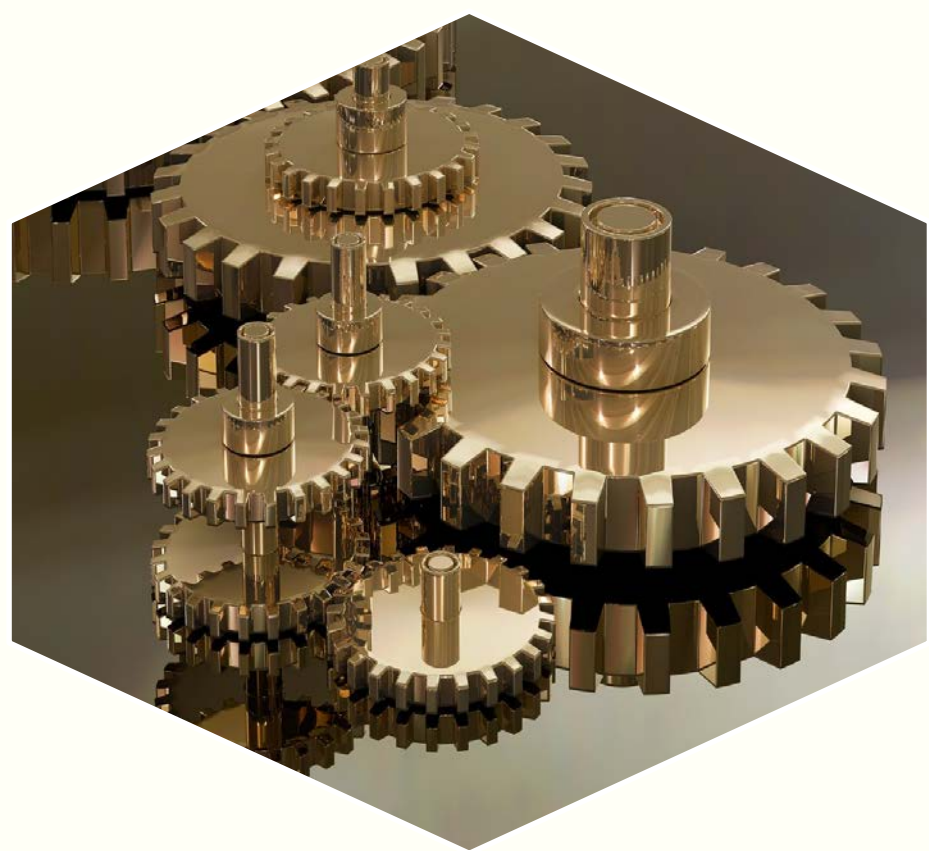
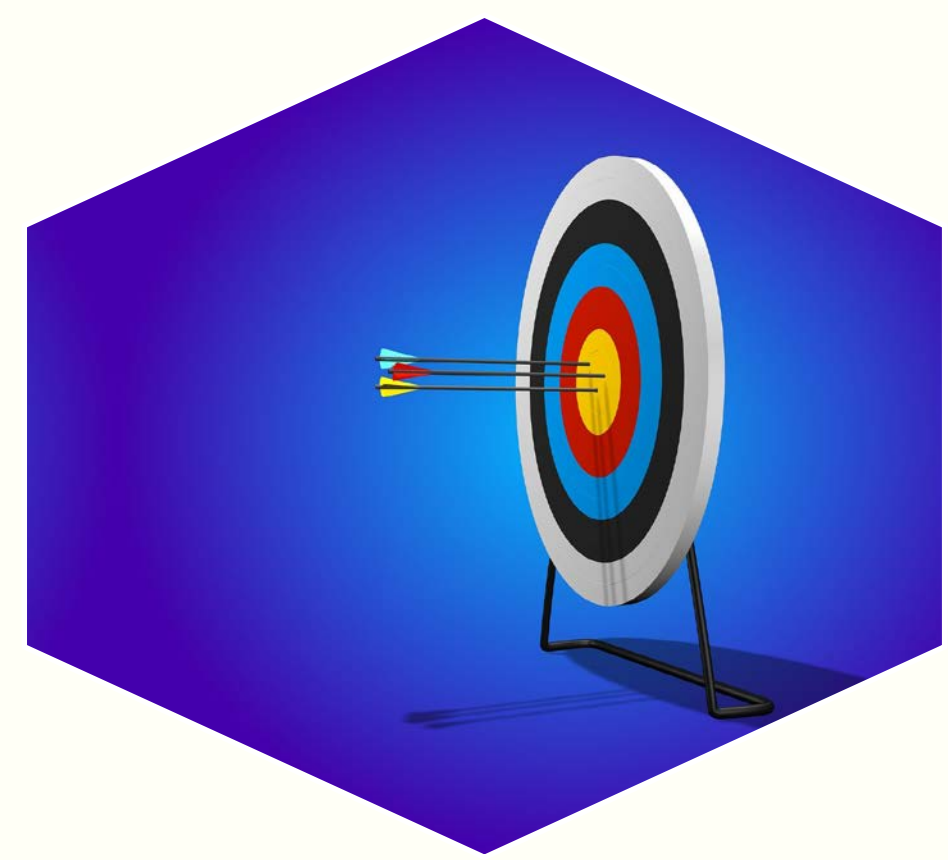


Introduction
